Great meeting! Thank you all for your participation and engagement, which is not easy in these virtual meetings.

Attached is **Laura's, Kent Cooperation Spill Kit Management program** presentation and materials for your use.

Below is the information from **Alison's, King Co. project BMP Program list** and request for your input. If you can offer insight she needs it **by this Friday, June 19th**.

As I mentioned during the BIG meeting, ECOSS was awarded a WaterWorks grant to translate and transcreate up to 10 of King County's stormwater BMPs (among other deliverables included in the grant). ECOSS and King County are in the process of refining the list of BMPs to translate and transcreate. ECOSS has refined the list to include just BMPs that are applicable to the following sectors: automotive, food service, and general property management.

Below is the draft list of BMPs ECOSS and King County have selected to translate and transcreate. Our ask to BIG is:

- **Are there any key BMPs missing**, again considering that the target sectors are automotive, food service, and general property management?
- **Are there any other BMPs that you commonly observe during inspections at automotive, food service, or general property management sites?**

Required BMPs for All Properties with Commercial Activities (i.e. CB maintenance, illicit discharges)	A-1
Storage of Liquid Materials	A-2 and A-3

Storage of Solid Waste and Food Wastes (Including Cooking Grease)	A-8
Storage of Scrap, Recycling Materials and Vehicle and Equipment Repair and Maintenance	A-9 and A-18
Cleaning or Washing of Tools and Equipment	A-11
Cleaning or Washing of Food Service Areas and Equipment	A-12
Vehicle Washing	A-13
Pressure Washing	A-15
Building Repair, Remodeling, and Construction	A-29
Vehicle and Equipment Parking and Storage and Sidewalk Maintenance	A-31 and A-32
